

7-a-side Development Tournament – Vienna 2013

The Austrian Disability Sports Federation – ÖBSV in cooperation with the Cerebral Palsy International Sports and Recreation Association – CPISRA hosted a 7-a-side Football Development Tournament from August 27th to September 1st, 2013 in Vienna, Austria. Four nations participated in event. The Singapore National Team, Netherlands Talent Team as well as newcomers Germany and Austria met in Vienna for four days of intense competition.

In the first three days the four teams competed in a robin round tournament format where the Dutch ended first, ahead of Germany only by goal difference as their first match ended in a 2x2 draw. Hosts Austria finished the group phase in 3rd place ahead of Singapore.

The last day of competition was finals day. The Netherlands Talent Team edged out Germany in a close 1x0 Final to crown themselves Champions of the Tournament. Austria pulled off a heroic 3x2 victory against Singapore for the bronze medal, with the winning goal practically being scored with the final whistle.

CPISRA 7-a-side Football Chair Tom Langen was present at the event and according to him, “it was a well-organized event and it was fantastic to see that two new countries Germany and Austria took part for the first time in an international competition. Besides this it was a great opportunity for a lot of new and young players to play for their national team. Congratulations to the organizers and all the participating teams”.
