


Athlete Survey

 - What areas if any need improvement within CP Football?




What type of athlete are you?

- Go to School/College and Play for your country 27.87%
- Part Time -get expenses for playing for your country and work part time 19.67%
- Work Full Time and Play for your country 19.67%




Will you continue to play International CP Football for your country after Rio Paralympic Games as Football 7 a side is not in Tokyo 2020?
