# Afrika and Asia-Oceaania Championships







# **K.A. Nº 2: Classifiers Training and Re-Certification**

- On-line Course to be launched in March 2019
- Re-certification actions according IPC self-audit.
- Offer 6-8 training opportunities at World Champs.
- Supervision of Classification contents in the development workshops.
- Cooperation with members that requires special attention.

# K.A. Nº 3: MIC Research

- Coordination testing at World Champs 2019:
  The HAA Approach
- Determining MIC cut-offs for ataxia and diskinesia.
- To be due in 2019-2020 = Inclusion in Classification Rulebook 2021-2024.

# K.A. Nº 4: Full Re-Classifications

- Letter to members at early 2019.
- Completing Classification of the main countries in World Champs 2019.

– 4 Classification panels may be required.

- RFD-20 cases in Qualification and Top-8 Tournaments.
  - Informing modifications for Paralympic Cycle 2021-2024.





# K.A. Nº 5: Female Para-Football

- Diversity requirements (i.e. IPC)
- Increase opportunities for elegibility:
  - Limb Deficiency
  - Impaired Range of Movement
  - Legs Lenght Difference
  - Impaired Muscle Power

# K.A. Nº 6: Point-System

- Actually in other Team Paralympic Sports.
- Reduce the pressure on players, teams and classifiers.
- Facilitates the players identification and selection.
- Game might be more "attractive" and challenging coaching.
- 12-15% of the players are VERY DIFFICULT to classify under the (new) current system.
- Recommendation for Team Para Sports: Multi-Skill





- 2. Countries with intention receive a Bid Document
- 3. Review of the Bid Document by Technical Committee
- 4. Adaptions of the Bid document
- 5. Approval of the Bid by the Board
- 6. Signing of the Host Contract
- 7. Monthly update by a Progress Report


